

## Alliance Française Oral Exam FAQ

### What time do we have to be there?

15 minutes before your scheduled time (see “prep” column in the schedule)

### Where will the Oral exam take place?

At ‘Alliance Française’ located on 75 Broadway St, Nedlands. Phone: 9386 7921

### Are there parking facilities?

On Saturday you can use UWA parking facilities, which are located directly opposite to Alliance Française

### Do we have to wear our uniform?

No, it is not necessary

### What do I need to bring along?

First of all, most importantly, you must be able to prove your identity with a photo ID card (student card is fine).

You may want to bring a pen for the preparation.

### How does the Alliance Française Oral Exam works?

On the schedule time, the student will be called into the preparation room (library) and receive their subject.

They will have 10 minutes to prepare.

They will then go with their examiner and be interviewed for 10 minutes.

### What will we be asked?

#### Year 10

You will be given a short text. You will need to read it and you will be asked comprehension questions about it.

The examiner will also ask you a few general questions about yourself.

#### Year 11

You will be given a discussion question. You will need to think about it, prepare your ideas and then talk about it with the examiner.

The examiner will also ask you a few general questions.

#### Year 12

You will be given a picture and you will need to invent a story from it.

The examiner will also ask you a few general questions.
