#### **Examination guidelines**

Year 9 & Year 10 Examinations → Written test only for all participants (no oral test) Date of the test: Tuesday 30 <sup>th</sup> of July 2024. Duration: 45 minutes - Listening: 15 min - Reading: 15 min - writing: 15 min	Year 11 & Year 12 Examinations1. Written test for all participants:Date of the test: Tuesday 30 <sup>th</sup> of July 2024.Duration: 1h30- Listening: 20 min- Reading: 30 min- Writing: 40 min2. Oral test for the 20 best students in each groupDate of the oral: Saturday 14 <sup>h</sup> of September 2024.
	<i>Location</i> : Alliance Française de Perth <u>75 Broadway, Nedlands 6009</u> <i>Duration</i> : 8 minutes (no preparation)

#### Organisation of the written test

- > Participating schools will hold the examination on their premises for their own students.
- > Not sitting the exam on the due day will automatically lead to disqualification.
- Dictionaries are permitted.
- > The timing of the exam is at the school's discretion, providing it is on the requested date.
- The examiner's decision is final.
- > A classification into two different categories A and B will apply:
- Category A: Students without special ties to France, or the French language and culture.
- Category B: Students with a connection to the French Language; (refer to the Category B form)

All documents will be sent to the schools in due course. Disclosing exam papers before the exam takes place will lead to automatic disqualification.

#### Laureates and prizes

Certificates will be awarded to all students sitting the written exam.

The three best Category A students from each level and the best Category B student in each level will be invited to the prize-giving ceremony which will take place on **Friday**, **25**<sup>th</sup> **October 2024** to receive their prize.

The list of laureates will be displayed on the Alliance Française' s website.

#### Description of Category B students:

Native French speaking students and <u>students who speak or have spoken French as their mother</u> <u>tongue</u>, all students who have <u>lived in a country where French is widely used</u>, students who attended a school in which French was the medium of instruction and students <u>whose parents were born in a</u> <u>French speaking country</u> or territory are considered as being a Category B student. All other students are Category A students.

Category B candidates are identified by the following:

- 1. Themselves 2. Their teacher 3. The Examination Commission
- 4. The markers of the oral examination component of the Alliance Française exams.

NB: If one of these four indicates that the candidate should compete in Category B, the candidate will be classified as a Category B candidate by the Alliance Française de Perth.

- 1. Please use the Excel enrolment form attached you can also download it from our website <u>https://www.afperth.com.au/french-courses-learn-french/af-french-schools-exams/</u>
- 2. The enrolment form shall include the **TYPED WHOLE ALPHABETICAL LISTING** of the students enrolled in each year.
- Please send all entry fees and enrolment forms to Alliance Française de Perth by email (<u>exam@afperth.com.au</u>) no later than Friday, 3<sup>rd</sup> of May 2024.
- 4. The entry fee is \$25 per student (including GST) from Yr9 to Yr12.
- 5. Payment is required at least 31 days after the deadline for enrolments, that is to say no later than Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> of June 2024. Payment not received within this period will lead to the cancellation of the enrolments.
